➤ Kalpana Chawla Health University at Village Kutail, Karnal.

The State Govt. has decided to establish a Health University as a Centre of Excellence on a piece of 100 acres of land being provided free of cost by Gram Panchayat Village Kutail, District Karnal. The Centre of Excellence will have all the Specialty Departments in addition to Super Specialty departments offering Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Post Doctoral Courses. The proposed Health University will also have institutions offering para medical and nursing courses at Graduate and Post Graduate Level besides research activities. The Medical College of this university will be for 200 MBBS admissions with a State of Art, 750 bedded Hospital with all modern equipments and facilities. The Expression of Interest for preparation of DPR of the project was invited from the interested parties. The evaluation of the Technical Bid documents received in response to the advertisement is under process by the technical evaluation team.

Establishment of New Govt. Medical College at Bhiwani.

State Government is establishing a Medical College at Bhiwani, as Central Share Scheme under "UPGRADATION OF DISTRICT HOSPITAL TO MEDICAL COLLEGE". 75% of the cost would be met by the Central Government and 25% by the State Government out of the total sum of Rs.189.00 Cr. The State Government Department of Medical Education & Research, Haryana has identified 179 Bigas 12 Biswa of Panchayat Land (Shamlet Land) of Village Prem Nagar, Bhiwani-Hansi Road, which is 7-8 K.M. from Bhiwani. The land already identified for the purpose has not been transferred in the name of this Department as the Panchayat has raised certain conditions (e.g. reservation in admission and employment) as well as certain observations (e.g. cost of the land) before transferring the land. The case has been sent to the Government for information and decision in the matter. The State Government signed the MoU and submitted it to Government of India. The Health Department has issued No Objection Certificate to attached the existing District Hospital to the

proposed medical college. The Concept Plan for the project has been prepared by the Technical Committee constituted by the Govt. for the purpose. The same is under consideration of Govt. for approval. Expression of Interest (EOI) has been invited from the interested parties for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) and lay out plans for the project. Last date for submission of EOI is 01.02.2016.

Establishment of New Govt. Medical College at Jind.

The State Government is proposing to establish a Govt. Medical College at District Jind with assistance from Central Govt. with proposal that 75% of the cost would be met by the Central Government and 25% by the State Government. The Deputy Commissioner, Jind has intimated that 20 acres of land has been identified for this purpose and a committee has been constituted to check the feasibility of the land for the said purpose and to submit the report for further action.

Establishment of AHMS at village Manethi District Rewari.

Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India has proposed to establish two AIIMS institute in India under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana has requested Hon'ble Health & Family Welfare Minister, Govt. of India to include State of Haryana in the proposal to set up AIIMS in the State. The State Government has identified a site of 200 acres in village Manethi District Rewari (Haryana) for setting up AIIMS.
